

CONCRETE MAKER SUED

Newark Laboratory Also Is Cited in Garage Collapse

TRENTON, N. J., July 25—

A suit seeking \$6,300,000 in damages was filed in Superior Court here today in connection with the collapse of the military park underground garage in Newark March 9.

The suit was initiated by the Terminal Construction Corporation of Wood-Ridge, N. J., against the John P. Callaghan Company of Harrison, concrete suppliers and the Newark Testing Laboratories.

Based on "information and belief" the Terminal suit charges a conspiracy to defraud on the contents and type of concrete supplied for the project.

Newark Testing and \$2,000,000 from Newark Testing alone.
